The Scholarship Program

The Scholarship Program was established in 2013 and is offered to a high school senior, college freshman or college sophomore as of 2017 in good academic standing who demonstrates leadership, community service, is of good character, and is interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement/criminal justice. The \$1,000 award will be payable in two installments of \$500 each semester.

Qualifications

- US citizenship
- State of Texas resident
- High school senior, college freshman or college sophomore (in 2017)
- 3.0 grade point average or higher
- Attending or planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college/university in the Fall of 2017
- Dependents of FBI employees are not eligible to apply

Application

- Must be received no later than February 15, 2017
- Must attach two letters of recommendation
- Must include essay

Award

The recipient will be announced in April 2017. The recipient will receive the award for the first semester at the time they enter the college/university stated on their application. They will receive the \$500 for the second semester at the time they provide documentation of registration.
